Primary text: Stand firm in the faith. Be courageous. Be strong. (1 Cor 16:13 NLT)

Primary point: Let us face the New Year with Christian courage.

What is courage?

Christian courage is obeying God without fear. (Phil 4:6-7 NLT; 1 Sam 17:48)

Why do we need courage?

To glorify God.

To obey God. (Joshua 1:2, 5-7, 9 NLT)

What will we need courage for?

How can we have Christian courage?

Christian courage can only come from being controlled by God's Spirit in us. (1 Sam 16:13).

What do we need to do for God's Spirit to control us? Believe the truth. Believing God's truth engages God's Spirit in us. Believe what specific truth? God loves you.
