"Being nice": A Pretty Lie in Church Clothes

Primary Point: We've crafted a comfort-Christianity that treats hatred as a failure of discipleship—but it's actually the proof of it.

Primary Text: Revelation 3:15-21

- 1. Never embrace philosophies that flatter the mind and starve the soul.
- 2. God goes where He is wanted, and He leaves where He's not.
- 3. God wants us to embrace being hated!

Application Questions:

- 1. Where am I lukewarm right now? What concrete act of repentance will I do this week to "open the door" to Jesus? (Rev 3:19–20)
- 2. What truth have I softened or silenced because I fear offense? When will I speak it with gentleness and respect?
- 3. Where am I "limping between two opinions"? Name the idol vs. the obedience—and choose today whom I will serve.
- 4. Talk about how social media is impacting your heart?
- 5. When I speak truth, do others experience gentleness and respect (1 Pet 3:15), or edge and superiority?
