Primary Point - As the tyrant plots my ruin, God uses him unwittingly for my sanctification.

Primary Text: Romans 7:15-8:1

1. **What does it mean to be a wretched man?**
2. **What does it mean to be "in Christ"?**
3. **How does justification and glorification make sanctification possible?**

Application questions:

1. What was most meaningful about today's message and why?
2. What emotion most reliably tells you the tyrant is talking?
3. What assumption about God, yourself, or salvation must be true for that accusation to work?
4. Is the tyrant accusing you of something Christ has already answered?
5. What lie about your identity feels most "obvious" but is least biblical?
6. How would your prayers change if you truly believed God is not prosecuting you?
7. What part of your sanctification feels impossible because you still feel unsafe?
8. What if the next accusation became a cue to ask, "What lie is being exposed right now?"
